What does a Christian/Clergy Counselor do?

This category of Counseling is made up of men and women who offer relationship counseling from a Biblical perspective.

Ordained Clergy & Christian Counselors

- Promote Emotional mental and Spiritual well-being
- Through Traditional Religious Training & modern psychology
- Specialize in areas of importance to God's People
- Support for those dealing with crisis of faith

When you seek out the help of a Faith Based Counselor, regardless of their religious affiliations, you can expect that the advice, direction and feedback will include conversations about spirituality and the impact your decisions have on your spiritual self.

What sets them apart?

- Includes & incorporates religious ideology into sessions
- Discussions include specific Biblical references
- Use parables from God's Word as examples for how to shape one's reality

What Can I Expect When I Work With A Faith Based Counselor?

Regardless of their religious affiliation, you can expect:

- Conversations about spirituality
- Discussions on the impact your decisions have on your spiritual self
- Religious ideology as a way to solve mental & spiritual matters
- Discussions about prayer
- Specific scripture texts for reading
- Christian Meditation (learning to be quite with God)
- How to apply God's Word to practical everyday decision making



Training & Credentials

In the U.S., due to the principle of separation of church and state, religious activities are not subject to regulation by the government. Therefore, Christian/Clergy Counseling is essentially a non-licensure track, but nevertheless a worthwhile path to pursue for help, especially if you are a strongly spiritual individual or couples.

Fee & Payment Arrangements

Sessions with a Christian/Clergy Counselor are 50 minutes and donations are due at the time of the session, first visit includes forms to be filled out and a beginning intake fee.

- Christian Faith Based Counseling costs less than traditional therapy due to its not-for-profit nature
- Offers low-cost help for those uninsured & cannot afford to pay for therapy
